Food, soft drinks and tea and coffee provided.

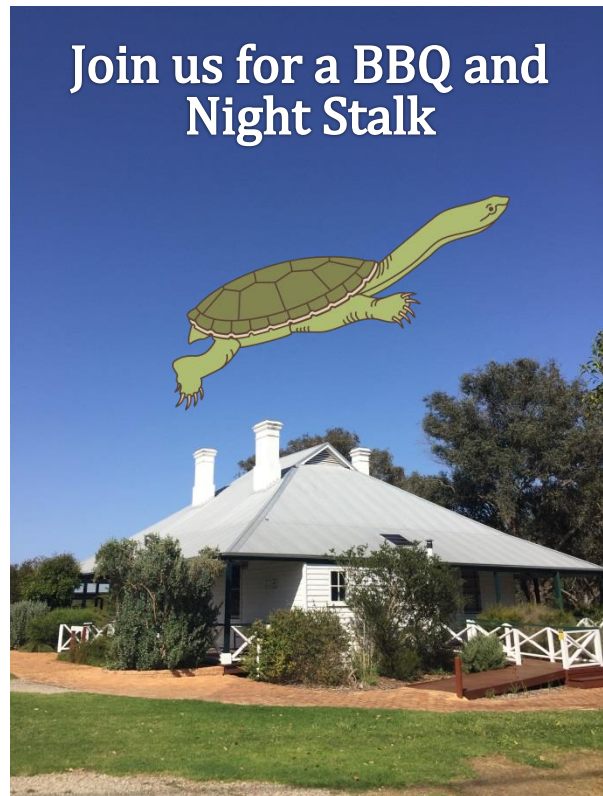

It is one of Australia's most successful community landcare initiatives and celebrates 20 years in 2018.
