


The Great Mozzie Checkup!



Look around your home.

Tick the box when you have completed the action.

Change the landscape in your garden to ensure drainage of standing water.	
Maintain sprinkler systems, control runoff and do not overwater.	
Repair outdoor dripping taps and leaky pipes.	
Keep grassy areas mowed short and remove weeds.	
Remove rubbish and other organic debris that collect water.	
Put sand in pot plant saucers to soak up water.	
Remove plants which store water in the bottom of their leaves.	
Make sure the wind can pass through areas.	
Make sure leaves do not collect in gutters and downpipes.	
Make sure drains are clean and clear of leaves and rubbish.	
Keep your swimming pool clean and healthy.	
Make sure pool covers do not collect water.	

Check for standing water around air conditioners.	
Keep native Western Pygmy Perch in ponds—they eat mosquito larvae!	
Plant local native plants to attract frogs and dragonflies—they eat mosquitoes!	
Empty bird baths once a week.	
Empty your pet's drinking water daily.	
Turn over boats, canoes and dinghies; so they can't fill with water.	
Make sure tyre swings have holes in the bottom to drain water.	
Put away outside toys so they don't collect water.	
Remove all tins, jars, tyres and other items which may hold water.	
Fit fly screens on all windows and doors.	
Make sure there are no holes in the fly screens on doors and windows.	
Check that outside lights are yellow. Insects don't like yellow lights!
